Gordon Harris - 1973 Oldsmobile Omega

Gordon Harris - 1973 Oldsmobile Omega

The vehicle was purchased in 1987 by my son Mark Harris at age 17. It was his first car. After it got to Moses Lake it was painted and new rims, tires and interior.

The vehicle was then purchased from him by his father Gordon Harris.

The Olds Omega was a compact car sold from 1973 through 1984 by General Motors.

The name Omega was the first generation two door coupe with production date 1973 to 1974 and had the style of the Chevy Nova, Pontiac Ventura, and Buick Apollo which were introduced in 1971.

The front grill sported the Olds trademark split "waterfall" grille, round headlights set into square recesses, and parking lights directly below the bumper.

It had a 350 engine with automatic transmission. The vehicle is a two door and has a vinyl top.

It had a little fancier trim than the Nova but it even borrowed the Nova dashboard but Olds added wood grain trim to it for a more upscale look.

The vehicle is for sale for only \$9,500 and can be seen in Moses Lake.
