I have restored this Kaiser to factory original condition on the exterior. Most of the outer body work and paint were done by Kenny at "Mild to Wild". The color is the original "Bermuda Tan" color. It has a stock 115 HP - 226 cubic inch Continental flathead 6 cylinder engine and a 3 speed manual transmission with overdrive.
